

UCI / EDISON INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

For Community College Transfer Students

GENERAL INFORMATION

Building on existing efforts to improve transfer rates, the University of California and Edison International will offer scholarships to CAMP eligible community college transfer students in Science, Engineering, and Mathematics. Each year for five years, up to 10 eligible community college transfer students will be awarded \$15,000 scholarships (\$7,500/yr for two years) to be used to complete bachelor of science degrees in computer science, life or physical science; mathematics; engineering or technology at UCI.

ELIGIBILITY

Community College transfer students must be admitted to the University of California, Irvine and:

- 1) Intend to enroll at the University of California, Irvine in Fall quarter 2008;¹
- 2) Declared science major in the following disciplines: Computer, Life, or Physical science, Mathematics; Engineering; or Technology;
- 3) Qualify for need-based financial aid;²
- 4) Commit to 25 hours of community service per year through UCI outreach programs.

1 The UCI / Edison International Scholarship Selection Committee recognizes that UCI will admit applicants for the Fall 2008 Quarter between March 1 and May 1, 2008. Scholarship applicants will be required to submit a positive statement of intent to register (PSIR) to UCI by June 1st, 2008. Applicants will be notified of their status by August 8th, 2008.

2 Receipt of this scholarship award may affect a student's financial aid package. Financial aid cannot be "over-awarded". Scholarships are forwarded to the UCI Financial Aid Office and fund are released quarterly.

- A copy of your **Financial Aid Award** letter from UCI (*This might be sent to you after the deadline. Please forward a copy to the UC-Edison Scholarship Committee upon receipt.*)
- If you do not attend a community college that is located in the Southern California Edison service area (list of eligible campuses follows), you must provide a copy of your residential Southern California Edison electric bill.
