### Centering All Students in the Classroom Community Using Culturally Responsive Read Alouds

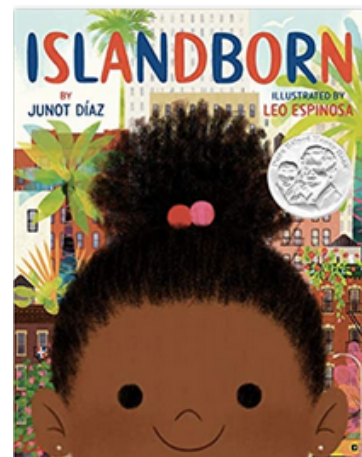
Sessions will provide participants the opportunity to:
